- Release and Authorization Form on page 4 (1 per each participant)

***If student is under 18, a parent or guardian must sign the release**

- Video link should be provided as You Tube Link and submitted to the website, www.sandiegocsda.weebly.com
- Upload application through website: www.sandiegocsda.weebly.com

Video Recording Content and Criteria

To be usable by Special Districts, local TV stations and movie theaters, your video must meet specific criteria.

- Be sure your video follows the "**What's So Special About Special Districts**" theme
- Video must be clearly G rated (subject to disqualification)
- Order and time lengths are very important when we process your video.

Follow this order and these times exactly:

- Title Page: video title, students involved, name of school and contest year
- Main Video
- Conclude with San Diego California Special Districts logo prominently displayed for 5 seconds.
- Total video length to be between 1-2 minutes.
